Due to COVID-19 concerns, we are currently offering Limited Hours and Services:

- Ramp-side Service (Pick-up & Returns): Tuesdays, 1 – 4 & Saturdays, 12 – 3
Ramp-side Service Instructions
- Beginning July 28: Brief In-Library Visits by Appointment are also available during Ramp-side Service hours. See detailed In-Library Visits Instructions To make an In-Library Appointment, please email the Librarian at domitke@gmail.com or call 736-2248.
 - COVID-19 In-Library Protocol will be posted at the library
 - Enter for Appointment through the Door at the Top of the Stairs
 - Limit to one patron or one family group (up to three people) per appointment
 - 15 minute appointments for reviewing the shelves & check-out/return
 - 30 minute appointments for computer use; only one desktop available
 - Masks are required for desktop use (masks provided if you don't have one)
 - All toys & children's computer unavailable at this time
 - Patrons will need to wash their hands when they enter the library
 - Hand Sanitizer available
 - Social Distancing (6 ft. apart)
 - Library items handled during appointment will be placed in a tote to be disinfected before being re-shelved.
 - Disinfection cleaning will be performed between appointments
